Maze Daiko



Mazeru is the Japanese word for "mix" and taiko (daiko) is the Japanese word for "drum". Maze Daiko creates an exciting mix of instrumentation and rhythms with the physical elegance and powerful sounds of taiko. Maze Daiko (pronounced Mah - Zeh) is garnering recognition for its unorthodox approach to combining traditional taiko rhythms and form with non-traditional instrumentation, energetic choreography and cross-cultural grooves. The members of Maze Daiko, Janet Koike, Cristine Sato, Elaine Fong, Kathryn Cabunoc, Tina Blaine and Carolyn West, all have years of collective experience in other ensembles including San Jose Taiko, Odaiko New England, UCLA Kyodo Taiko, Emeryville Taiko, RhythMix, D'CuCKOO and more.
