Registered Lions Clubs are encouraged to have hospitality rooms. Hospitality rooms will have direct access to the courtyard where outdoor activities are scheduled. Due to the limit of 10 available rooms, hospitality rooms will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis and must be reserved for a minimum of three (3) nights. Hospitality rooms will be available at check in time of 3:00pm – clubs wishing to have their hospitality rooms open in the morning must reserve the room the day before.

Damages and charges made to the Hospitality Rooms will be the responsibility of the Club reserving the room. All debris left in the rooms at the end of the Convention is the responsibility of the Club to remove and dispose of. District 4-C4 will fine and pass along all costs of clean up for failure to comply to the Club reserving the room. **Room Keys will only be issued to the Club Representative listed below.**
