



District 4-C4 - Disaster Preparedness

Disaster Home Kit

Store in a cool dry place. (Up to 7 days)

- ◇ Gloves, robust work gloves and protective.
- ◇ Dust masks (To help filter contaminated air).
- ◇ First Aid Kit, Medical items, Prescriptions, spare glasses.
- ◇ Drinking water, 1 gallon per day.
- ◇ Household chlorine bleach, no scent or added cleaners.
- ◇ Food non-perishable, Seven-day supply min.
- ◇ Matches in a waterproof container.
- ◇ Manual Can Opener for stored food in cans.
- ◇ Flashlights, extra batteries.
- ◇ Emergency Cash.
- ◇ Personal Hygiene Items, Toothbrush, comb etc.
- ◇ Battery or crank powered radio, NOAA weather channel.
- ◇ Toilet paper, wipes, soap.
- ◇ Whistle (signal for help or rescue).
- ◇ Spare clothing, warm and waterproof, sturdy shoes.
- ◇ Sleeping Bags, Emergency Blankets for each person.
- ◇ Mess kit, plates, cups, utensils, paper towels.
- ◇ Garbage bags and Duct tape. (Emergency shelter, sanitation).
- ◇ Plastic sheeting, zip ties, rope (Shelter in Place).
- ◇ Copies of important family documents.
- ◇ Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities, know where to beforehand.
- ◇ Local Maps.
- ◇ Books, puzzles, other activities to keep children busy.
- ◇ Cellphone backup battery.
- ◇ Fire Extinguisher.

Pull the kit out once a year and check/update contents.
